

*The camera scans the member's temperature, then the member scans their key for access.*

*The high temperature threshold is 37.3 degrees celsius.*

*If a member scans over this threshold temperature, the gate will not open.*

*In this event, the member will be given a second opportunity to scan their temperature on the access gates. If the temperature is under the threshold temperature, entry will be allowed.*

*If the second scan is over the threshold temperature, a third temperature scan using a hand held infrared thermometer will be performed (these are available at reception).*

*This will be aimed at the inner ear and temperature read.*

*If this third temperature reading is under the threshold temperature, the member will be allowed entry.*

*If this reading is over the threshold temperature, then access will be denied and the member's account frozen until a COVID-19 clearance is produced.*

*Casual visitors and pass holders will also need to scan their temperature prior to entry.*
